Take Exit 191 off Interstate 95 onto the Kelley Road, turn right (east) and travel until Kelley Road ends at an intersection. Turn left (north) and travel through Orono. After crossing the Stillwater River, bear right at the top of the hill. Travel about a mile until you see the University of Maine entrance on the left. After entering the University, bear left at the fork and you will see the Collins Center for the Arts.
